MINISTRY DESCRIPTIONS:

CHILDREN'S DAY OUT - There are four age appropriate rooms (infants, one year olds, two year olds and plus two=s). This is a year round program that meets Monday-Thursday from 9:00-12:00 on a first come first serve basis. The staff consists of a coordinator and a regular paid worker in each room plus a volunteer helper. Parents/volunteers sign up to help. The fee is \$8.00 a day for the first child and \$2.00 for each additional child in the same family. CDO will be closed the week of Vacation Bible School and the week of July 4.

SUMMER BLUE LAKE CAMP DATES - Ala-West Florida Methodist Camps for children entering fourth-sixth grades are offered the weeks of June 9, 16, 23, July 6, 21, 24 (Father/son camp) and 31 (Mother/Daughter Camp). SUMMER ENRICHMENT PROGRAM - is for children entering 3 & 4 yr old Preschool, Kindergarten, or First grade this fall. You can sign up for as many as four weeks of learning and fun centered around children's favorite Bible stories. The program will run Monday through Thursday from 9-12 during the weeks of June 16, June 23, July 7, and July 14. Cost for each program is \$35 per week with a one time \$10 (per family) registration and supply fee. Applications are available at the receptionist desk in the Mathison lobby.
